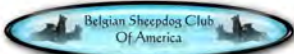

Entries must be received by **6 pm CDT Wednesday, March 24** after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing (email is acceptable) prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient fees will have the entry cancelled; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging. Express & certified deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature. **Entries received without signature release will be refused.**

Entries with email addresses will be acknowledged with an email receipt. Confirmations and judging schedules will be emailed after closing. If you want a hard copy confirmation mailed, please note this on your entry. CAPER is not responsible for non-delivery of emails due to delivery errors or spam blockers, and no further efforts will be made.

Refunds: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Event Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Event Committee make it impossible to open or complete the show/trial. Refunds will be given, less \$5 per entry, for bitches entered in scentwork, agility, obedience or rally who come into season after the closing date, if written notice is given to the Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of judging of that event's classes.

Fax/email entries: Entries may be faxed to the Secretary at 206-222-2830, or emailed to secretary@caper-dogs.com. Both sides of each entry form must be included, completely filled out and signed, or the entry will not be accepted. Payment can be made via PayPal or credit card by going to www.caper-dogs.com/PayPalCCpayment.htm and following the instructions there. **Payment must include the \$2 per class additional charge to be valid.** Entries are complete when both entry form and payment are received.

Entry errors: Exhibitors are responsible for the correctness of entries. All entries which include an email address will be sent an entry verification email shortly after receipt. All errors will be corrected prior to closing; exhibitor errors discovered after closing cannot be corrected. Overpayments of less than \$5 per dog will not be refunded.

Transfers: Dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, or higher level in the other events after the closing of entries for these events, may be transferred to the higher class. Each of these transfer requests must be made to, and accepted by, the Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the event's judging.

- The TD test is limited to 4 entries. Entries for the TD test for dogs without a TD title must have included with the entry form a notice of certification from an AKC tracking judge stating the dog is ready for such a test.
- The TDX test is limited to 4 entries. TDX entrants must have a TD title.
- The draw for entries and alternates will be held at 7pm CDT on Wednesday, March 24 at the Test Secretary's address. All participants and alternates will be notified as soon as possible after the draw. Upon notification, alternates shall have the option of accepting or refusing the opportunity to participate in the test. In the event an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, the first alternate entry present according to the order in which they were drawn shall fill the vacant position. Refunds will be made for any alternate who is does not participate in the draw for tracks, and for any absent/withdrawn entrant whose track is filled by an alternate.

- Herding tests/trials are open to all AKC herding breeds (Belgian Sheepdogs preferred) Sun 4/25, & Belgian Sheepdogs only Mon 4/26. There will be two trials on Monday.
- Entries are limited to 50 runs on Sunday and 25 runs per trial on Monday. If entry limits are reached, additional entries will be put on an alternate list.
- Sheep Trial each day: Advanced Course A, Intermediate Course A, Started Course A.
All sheep trial classes will be in a 135' x 250' arena.
- Herding Test and Pre-trial Tests will be held with each sheep trial.
The PT tests will be in a 160' x 250' arena. The HT tests will be in a 106' x 152' arena.
- Herding Instinct testing will be held with each sheep trial.
- A dog may be entered in a Trial class and a Test class for each sheep trial. However, either the Test or Trial entry should be designated the priority entry on the entry form, should the entry limits be reached. The other entry will be then taken as an alternate.
- Alternate list entrants must check in with the Trial Secretary on the grounds no later than 30 minutes prior to start of trial each day. Alternates that do not have the chance to run will have entry fee srefunded. Refunds will be made to accepted entrants ONLY if an alternate is available to take their place.

The Novice & Open classes are divided (ages as of the day of the show):

- Novice & Open Junior - 9 years and under 12 years
- Novice & Open Intermediate - 12 years and under 15 years
- Novice & Open Senior - 15 years and under 18 years

Master class: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

PLEASE NOTE: Juniors must include their AKC Junior Handler number on the entry blank. Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form. Dogs shown in Junior Showmanship may have Full or Limited AKC registration or have an ILP/PAL number. Altered animals are eligible to be shown, but bitches in season are not eligible.

FOUR TO SIX MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for Belgian Sheepdogs that are 4 months of age but under 6 months on the day of the event. An AKC registration number or litter number will be required for each entry. A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.

- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs/has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last 5 years.
- All entries must be received by the closing date. No entries will be taken at ringside.

AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

All dogs that are owner-handled and are not owned, co-owned or exhibited by professional handlers* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dogs are Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book & the catalog. **Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and assistants to current professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any breed competition during the entire show.**

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

* Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in this competition.
